Jeff spent the next year performing, dancing and Choreographing in preparation for his first workshop. Jeff's skill as a cuer and his humorous presentation style struck a chord with the dancers, and offers for more workshops began to come in.

Since that time, Jeff's teaching schedule has grown to include dozens of workshop appearances a year. He has taught throughout the U.S., Canada, Europe and Australia and has received numerous awards and honours. Over his years of teaching, he has written over 300 dances, including Television Breakdown, Ida Red, Marry Me, Spirit of the Hawk and many more.

As a performer, Jeff has made several appearances with the Opry Square Dancers on the Grand Ole Opry, and in shows with Country Music artists Vince Gill, Bryan White, Ricky Skaggs and others. His choreography has been performed in national parades, international festivals, Super Bowl Halftime Shows, theme parks and more.

Jeff has served as an officer in many national clogging organizations, and is the owner and editor of the Double Toe Times clogging magazine.

If you have never experienced Jeff's workshops before you are in for a memorable, fun experience.

Jeff began clogging in 1980, where he danced to live bluegrass music every weekend at clogging halls around town. Soon after, he joined a performing group called the Black Bear Cloggers.

In 1983 at a teaching session in Fontana, North Carolina he was offered a staff teaching spot by Bobbie and Dewey Paul of Ohio.
